



Volunteer Position Description: GENERAL VOLUNTEER

The Kids Up Front Volunteer Program has been designed to help facilitate various opportunities that are available to Kids Up Front participants throughout the year. These opportunities range depending on the type of volunteer position you choose.

1. Volunteer Role

General volunteers are considered to be Level 1 volunteers. The general volunteer position consists of mainly fundraising and community events; general volunteers don't work with youth so there is no reason to have a Vulnerable Sector check. These opportunities vary from selling Chuck a Puck with the Oil Kings and 50/50 raffles, to lending a helping hand at our annual fundraiser District of Dreams.

2. Program Objective

The objective of the Kids Up Front volunteer program is to have the manpower to provide more events to our community. In order to do that, we need your help!

3. Job Responsibilities

Most responsibilities remain the same, but there will be some instances where responsibilities change depending on the event that you are working. Main general volunteer responsibilities include:

- Handling money
- Running booths at public events
- Volunteering at our annual fundraiser District of Dreams
- Answering questions about Kids Up Front
- Being a representative of Kids Up Front

4. Time Commitment

Similarly to volunteer responsibilities, time commitment changes depending on which event you choose to volunteer at. General volunteers (Level 1) will have opportunities that will vary from a couple of hours to a full day at our fundraiser.

5. Training

Volunteers are required to attend an orientation session in person at the office, located at the Orange Hub (#153, The Orange Hub 10045 156 St NW). Volunteers are welcome to attend as many orientation sessions as they feel they need throughout their time as a volunteer.
